March 13th AND 14th Ukrainian Egg Dying (Pysanky) with Molly Wilhelm

YOU DON'T WANT TO MISS THIS CLASS!! Molly has done this beautiful art form for many years. Pysanky is a traditional craft in Ukraine and Poland. The method is similar to batik - patterns are drawn on the egg with wax, which then protects the covered areas from the dye that is applied. By repeating this process with different colors of dye, a multi-colored pattern is built up. Finally, the wax is removed to reveal the colors that were covered up at each stage. A layer of polyurethane will be added over the finished egg to protect the dyed design and to give a gloss finish. You must be able to attend both evenings to complete your egg. Molly will provide all the supplies you will need (even the eggs). Wear old clothes to this one! The class will be held at the new Outreach/Community Ed. building (**The last building on the left as you are going north toward the football field on 12th street. There is a big metal EWC sign on the end of the building**). It is from 6:00-9:00 both evenings. The cost is \$15.00
